



FF Lisandro Breeding Contract

This contract applies for the 2018/2019 breeding season.

And is between:

Fanfaire Equestrian and the mare owner



Fees:

- The Service Fee is \$1750 (including GST).
 - The Service Fee of \$1750 must be paid in full prior to semen being required for artificial insemination (AI) requirements and will be invoiced accordingly. Semen cannot be picked up by the mare owner or their agent without payment having been made in full.
 - If the service is to be live cover the Service Fee of \$1750 (including GST) must be paid prior to serving.
 - If the mare is not in foal after the first AI, a second collection fee of \$250 will be incurred, and this will continue for each collection required.
 - A service certificate will be provided to the mare owner once fees are paid in full and a 42-day pregnancy confirmed.

Live Foal Guarantee:

- A Live Foal Guarantee (LFG) exists to cover the foal up to 24 hours after birth.
- The LFG will not apply if the mare is sold, is no longer within New Zealand, or is no longer alive for any reason.
- If the mare is not foaled under approved supervision at a veterinary establishment the LFG will not apply unless a vet report indicates that the death of the foal was not preventable in any way.
- The LFG will not cover the loss of the foal within the first 24 hours for any reasons which are deemed to be due to fault of care, lack of supervision or avoidable by reasonable means. Examples include any incidents related to fencing accidents, unsuitable paddocks, the foal being injured by its mother, not being able to feed, breach or red bag deliveries etc.
- Please note, the above applies in particular to mares foaled without veterinary care (eg, on the owner's property/a friend's property or any other non-veterinary establishment). The LFG will still apply IF a vet report is produced saying the death was not preventable. However, the mare owner must carry the risk that should a vet report indicate the death as preventable then the mare owner will forfeit the LFG.
- The LFG cannot be on-sold, and will not follow the mare if she is sold-in-foal.

- The LFG will be forfeited if the stallion dies or becomes unfit for breeding following breeding season.
 - Please note: - we really want you to have a living healthy foal. We will work very hard on our end with our stallion to ensure we provide you with every opportunity to have that foal. Our LFG very much comes down to our expectation that you in turn will do everything within your power and the resources available to you to ensure you provide your mare with every opportunity to produce a live healthy foal when it comes to the time of birth.

Initiating a RETURN SERVICE or LFG


- If a live foal does not eventuate (re-absorption, slipped foal, non-preventable death etc.) a return service will be provided for the season of the foal's birth to FF Lisandro. This is conditional however on a veterinary certificate summarising the reason for the loss of foal.
 - If the LFG is requested due to the foal becoming deceased or being euthanized within 24 hours of being born, the mare owner must notify the stallion owner as soon as possible. After a veterinary certificate is provided as evidence of a deceased foal and to confirm that the cause of death was not preventable by the mare owner, another contract will ensure between the mare owner and the stallion owner for a return service.
 - Please note, should a return service be offered under the LFG, the mare owner will be re-charged the collection fee of \$250 and a new contract will apply.
 - The Return Service/ LFG must be used that same season in which the foal born unless agreed otherwise between mare and stallion owner.
 - If the original mare becomes unbreedable for any reason, the mare owner may nominate a second mare in writing, but this mare must be approved as suitable in terms of pedigree and/or competitive record by Fanfaire Equestrian.
 - A return service/LFG cannot be on-sold
 - A return service/LFG will be forfeited if the stallion dies or becomes unfit for breeding for the following breeding season.

Gelding Policy

- To ensure quality and integrity of bloodlines are maintained, all colts sired by FF Lisandro must be gelded prior to 24 months of age and must not serve any mares during their lifetime.
- This gelding policy is also intended to ensure that the worth of FF Lisandro progeny are not de-valued as a result of unsuitable colt siring future progeny.
- Veterinary Certificate of gelding is required to be produced on request.
- Fanfaire Equestrian reserves the right to charge a fee to the colt owner of NZ \$20,000 if this gelding policy is ignored.
- If the colt foal has been sold in-utero or after birth, it remains the responsibility of the signatory of this contract to ensure the new owner is aware of this gelding policy and to forward acknowledgement of it to Fanfaire Equestrian.

This ID form must be returned with signed contract before semen is sent.
